

## Lap Band Profiled

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For individuals who end up deciding to Choose Lap Band, they will undergo a procedure that has proven both affective and popular with many patients in recent years.

What makes lap band surgery clearly different from other bariatric procedures is that it is done laparoscopically. The process of having lap band surgery requires a surgeon to make five or six tiny incisions in the abdomen as opposed to one very large incision typically used in other procedures.

Not only does this approach result in less scarring for the patient, but it also means less time for the patient in the hospital. The usual outlook for the majority of patients is a shorter recovery time and only a few days out of work.
